Hindu dhimmitude encoded in Constitution?

- **Yes. By Negation of Foundational Principle of Democracy i.e, Article 14 Equality before Law:**

“The State shall not deny to any person equality before the law or the equal protection of the laws within the territory of India.”

Thanks to Harendra Coomar Mookerjee, a Christian leader of Bengal, Vice-President of Constituent Assembly & Chairman, Minority Rights Committee, with support of Nehru, Azad *et al*, the subsequent Articles especially 25(2) - 30 negate the very foundational principle of democracy to the total detriment of Majority Hindus by relegating them to 2nd class status.

**What are the terrible
Consequences of this self-imposed
Dhimmitude?**

Dhimmitude No. 1

**Only Hindus are deprived of control
over their temples and religious affairs**

Article 26: Freedom to manage religious affairs:

“Subject to public order, morality and health, every religious denomination or any section thereof shall have the right

(a) to establish and maintain institutions for religious and charitable purposes;

(b) to manage its own affairs in matters of religion;

(c) to own and acquire movable and immovable property; and

(d) to administer such property in accordance with law.”

Article 25: Freedom of religion

“(1) Subject to public order, morality and health and to the other provisions of this Part, all persons are equally entitled to freedom of conscience and the right freely to profess, practise and propagate religion

(2) Nothing in this article shall affect the operation of any existing law or prevent the State from making any law

(a) regulating or restricting any economic, financial, political or other secular activity which may be associated with religious practice;

(b) providing for social welfare and reform or the throwing open of Hindu religious institutions of a public character to all classes and sections of Hindus”

A Fundamental Question

- **How can secular Govt control/manage religious places that too of only one religion?**
- **It is perfectly legal and understandable if India were a Hindu Rasthra.**
- **Since Constitution ordains India to be Secular, the Govt can either take over religious places of all Religions or of None.**
- **It can NOT pick and choose to take over only Hindu Temples. That is not only discriminatory to Hindus but Anti-Secular too.**

Consequences

- **Loss of Pride – Are Hindus so incapable that they can't manage their Temples etc?**
- **State control of Hindu religious affairs – TTD priests' retirement age, direction against Sanskrit Mantras in TN**
- **Crass commercialization of Temples**
- **Misuse & misappropriation of Temple lands, funds**
- **Penury of Archakas, Pujaris – beggars can't have self-confidence**
- **No investment on protecting and propagation of Haindavam**
- **Appointment of Non-Hindus in Temple Boards and as Temple employees**

Dharma dies without Temples

- **Temples & Mutts being life and soul of Hinduism, control over them Dharma won't survive for long — that's why all Abrahamic invaders destroyed or undermined Temples.**
- **Govt appropriation of temple wealth has deprived Hindu society of institutional capacity for self-correction, self-defence, religious leadership and organic growth while Churches and Masjids allowed large resource capacity to present to their flock in terms of education, hospitals, orphanages etc.**
- **For survival of Hindu Dharma, it must have control over its religious institutions.**

Amend Article 26 to Restore Temples to Hindus

Insert following in Article 26:

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in article 25, the State shall not control, administer or manage, whatsoever, any institution, including its properties, established or maintained for religious or charitable purposes by a religious denomination or any section thereof.

(3) All laws in force in the territory of India in so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this article shall, to the extent of such inconsistency, be void.

(4) The State shall not make any law which enables it to control, administer or manage, whatsoever, any institution, including its properties, established or maintained for religious or charitable purposes by a religious denomination or any section thereof, and, any law made in contravention of this clause shall, to the extent of such contravention, be void.

Vacuum?

- **No. 28 of Concurrent List of 7th Schedule – *Charities and charitable institutions, charitable and religious endowments, and religious institutions***
- **Hence, Centre should enact a Law by taking best practices from Sikh Gurudwaras Act, Waqf Act & other laws etc providing for basic framework of temple management with rule making powers to States to accommodate the local and special requirements**

Advantages

- Restores Pride and self-confidence among Hindus and its religious leaders – a necessary condition to fight against aggressive conversions, protect/promote Dharma etc
- Use temples and their resources for protection, promotion and propagation of Dharma, Haindava samskruti, running orphanages, old age homes, help downtrodden Hindus etc
- Expand in to religious/spiritual arena.

Dhimmitude No. 2

**State has become the biggest
Proselytizer by Encouraging
Conversion of Hindus by misuse of
public funds etc**

Article 27

Freedom as to payment of taxes for promotion of any particular religion:

“27. No person shall be compelled to pay any taxes, the proceeds of which are specifically appropriated in payment of expenses for the promotion or maintenance of any particular religion or religions denomination.”

Consequences of ambiguity in Article 27

- **A false narrative of Minorityism was created, so much so that PM Manmohan Singh made a notorious statement of Minorities having the 1st charge on national resources**
- **Minority politics and appeasement by misuse of public funds to the detriment of Majority, has become bane of the country**
- **Separate Ministries/Depts, Finance Corporations, Commissions, Budgets, Scholarships, Schemes, Pilgrimage Subsidies etc**
- **Electoral politics and Minorities voting as a bloc, Political Parties indulge in competitive Minority appeasement to beat record of their opponents and/or previous regimes**

- **Even BJP, which has NO chance of getting minority votes, falls into this trap of competitive Minority appeasement.**
- **Minority voting pattern – No amount of appeasement, TT etc – Karnataka, Kairana**
- **TT will only smoothen L J**
- **“The Majority Report” by J P Sharma & Ram Ohri**
- **Result: State incentivising and encouraging conversion of Hindus to get these benefits**

A fundamental question on the nature of Indian State

When the State patronises Minorities so much and thereby encourages and incentivizes conversion of Hindus, how is it different from the Missionaries and Mullahs in its character?

Amend Article 27 to end Minority politics

Insert following in Article 27:

"(2) No moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of India, the Consolidated Fund of a State, the Contingency Fund of India or the Contingency Fund of a State or out of the fund of any public body shall be appropriated for advancement or promotion of a section of citizens solely or primarily on the basis of their religious affiliation or belonging to one or more religious or linguistic denomination."

This amendment will end politics of competitive Minority appeasement, prevent State from incentivising conversions of Hindus by misuse of public funds, restore pride and self-confidence among Hindu masses that they are not Dhimmis and enthuse Hindus to consolidate

Dhimmitude No. 3

**Deracination of Hindus to self-loath
and disown their religion, culture and
history**

1st Phase of Deracination of Hindus

- **Who were in charge of Indian mind space?**
- **Out of 30 years (1947-77) the following were Education Ministers for 20 years**
 - **Maulana Abul Kalam Azad – 11 years (1947-58)**
 - **Humayun Kabir, M C Chagla & Fakruddin Ali Ahmed – 4 years (1963-67)**
 - **Nurul Hassan – 5 years(1972-77)**
- **Remaining 10 years other Leftists like VKRV Rao**

What did they do?

- **Industrial scale distortion of History, negation and whitewashing of bloody Islamic invasions/rule;**
- **Prime Eg: Names of Roads/Public places in Delhi – as if Delhi was founded by Invaders – No mention about Krishna/Pandavas the original builders of Delhi**
- **Enormous patronisation of pro-Left & pro-Minority academicians/scholars by Govt;**
- **Systematic sidelining/elimination of all pro-Hindu Nationalist academicians/scholars by Govt;**
- **Formal education means Deracination – since density of schools/colleges was less, many had no formal education and thereby remained rooted in Haindavam**

1980s – Phase of Inadvertent Re-Hinduisation

- **1982 – Nation wide Color TV transmission (Asian Games);**
- **1986 – Ramjanmabhumi gates were opened;**
- **1987-88 – Ramanand Sagar’s Ramayan serial (78 episodes);**
- **1988-89 Lav-Kush TV serial (39 episodes);**
- **These 2 serials which ran for 117 weeks re-awakened Hindu spirit and re-Hinduised the Hindu society on a massive scale;**
- **Hard work of RSS/VHP galvanised re-Hinduised Hindus leading to massive Hindu consolidation and success of Advani’s Rath Yatra in 1990, and unprecedented growth of BJP (From 2 MPs in 1984 to 85 in 1989 and 120 in 1991)**

From 1990s – 2nd phase Deracination of Hindus

- **Anti-Hindus having understood the process of re-Hinduisation in 1980s, started an intensive and extensive de-Hinduisation of every aspect of education and public instruction**
- **Recall the so called De-Toxification *meaning* De-Hinduisation & Abrahamisation of Public Instruction, Mass Media/Entertainment, Public Discourse etc**

Since ancient times, one can observe the birth and development of various religions in world history. Hinduism, Jainism and Zoroastrian religions were developed in various centuries of B.C.E and spread across the world. Though Christianity and Islam were established after First century C.E, they have become major world religions. CHRISTIANITY

Not just limited to academics

De-Hinduisation has been underway in a massive scale in mass media, art, literature, entertainment, cinemas

In fact Cinemas have gone a step ahead by Christo-Islamisation – one hardly finds Hindu imagery nowadays but Christo-Islamic imagery is in abundance both in Lyrics & Visuals even though the plot and characters are Hindu.

Articles 28 & 30

28. (1) No religious instruction shall be provided in any educational institution wholly maintained out of State funds.

30 (1) All minorities, whether based on religion or language, shall have the right to establish and administer educational institutions of their choice.

Fragmentation of Hindu society

- **State prescribes fee, admission procedure, syllabi and regulates every aspect of functioning including staff salaries, of only Majority Hindu educational institutions but NOT of Minorities**
- **To escape State tyranny various sections of Hindu society demand separate religion status – Sikhs, Jains, Rama Krishna Mission, Lingayat etc**

De-Hinduisse & Abrahamise Mindspace

- **Every ancient Indian text and civilizational knowledge/ teaching has been classified as Religious Instruction under Article 28 and banished them from teaching in Govt schools, Govt aided schools and those receiving State grants etc by pejorating it as Saffronisation**
- **Whereas Minority schools continue to teach their Religious texts even though they receive State grants but protected by Article 30.**

Result

- **Hindu children denied access to Hindu texts and their civilizational knowledge, but since Govt/Minority school text books contain Christo-Islam, the Hindu kids get to know more about Islam and Christianity but very little about Hinduism and Hindu civilisation.**
- **Thus Hindus are deracinated and brain washed to disown their own culture and history making them ripe for easy conversion**

- **Unless Hindu society is re-Hinduised it is impossible to prevent its fragmentation leading to eventual destruction of Hinduism.**
- **And without Hinduism there is neither RSS nor BJP.**

Amend Articles 28 & 30

Insert following in Article 28:

"(4) Nothing in this Constitution shall be deemed to forbid the teaching of traditional Indian knowledge or ancient texts of India in any educational institution, wholly or partly maintained out of State Funds."

In Article 30 substitute word "minorities" with "all sections of citizens".

Private Member Bill of Dr Satyapal Singh

- On 6-6-2016 Dr Satyapal Singh ji introduced a Private Member's Bill in Lok Sabha covering all the above for amendment of Articles 26-30.
- Unless the Bill is adopted and made into a Govt Bill and got passed in LS, it will lapse in April, 2019.

Is this Bill Anti-Minority?

- **None of the rights or privileges of Minorities are sought to be taken away. Only extend those to all sections.**
- **All that is suggested is to treat everybody equally i.e., State and laws to be religion-neutral, extend same rights and privileges to all without consideration of religion.**
- **In fact, Syed Shahabuddin, despite his brand of politics, was against Article 30. He had introduced a Private Member's Bill (Bill No. 36 of 1995 Lok Sabha) to extend the privileges to all sections.**
- **The Bill being perfectly in tune with the Foundational Principle of Democracy i.e., Equality before Law, is NOT Anti-Minority even remotely**

Amendment nuances

- **As per Article 368, amendment of Part-III does not require 50% States consent.**
- **So get the Bill passed by Lok Sabha immediately and send it to Rajya Sabha.**
- **Get it passed by Rajya Sabha after 2019 elections by which time BJP will have got majority in Rajya Sabha.**

The Bill furthers the Mission of RSS

“The Hindu culture is the life-breath of Hindusthan. It is therefore clear that if Hindusthan is to be protected, we should first nourish the Hindu culture. If the Hindu culture perishes in Hindusthan itself, and if the Hindu society ceases to exist, it will hardly be appropriate to refer to the mere geographical entity that remains as Hindusthan. Mere geographical lumps do not make a nation.”

Opposition Unity Vs Hindu Consolidation

- **Hindu Consolidation**
 - Inversely proportional to electoral of Third Front or Casteist parties
 - Inversely proportional to Index of Opposition Unity
 - Directly proportional to Electoral Success of BJP

RSS/BJP's Self Interest is National Interest

- **Hindu Consolidation is definitely at a lower level than it was during 2013-14**
- **The core constituency is becoming indifferent just like in 2004, which the BJP may ignore at its own peril.**
- **The Bill will enthuse and galvanise the core constituency, and consolidate majority in favour of the BJP without antagonizing the minorities.**
- **It will silently re-orient minority-centric politics and end religion-based discrimination encoded in laws.**

Finally

- **A Govt should never be defensive about its ideology and beliefs, because in politics that's what (ideology and beliefs) people have voted it to power.**
- **Don't seek endorsement of people on the other side as that will spell political death knell as had happened in 2004.**
- **Instead, always nurture and motivate your support base by implementing your core ideology, because that's what will get you elected again.**
